

PHIN OPCS 4.10 update guidance

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In line with the NHS, PHIN has implemented an updated version of the OPCS Classification of Interventions and Procedures – from OPCS 4.9 to OPCS 4.10 - from the 1st of April 2023. This will be a mandatory change for all providers submitting Admitted Patient Care (APC) data to PHIN.

The update to the standard is a continuance of the regular review and uplift of OPCS-4 in line with the recommended best practice of keeping clinical classifications aligned with advances in health care.

Any APC data submitted to PHIN relating to patients discharged on or after the 1st of April 2023 must be coded using OPCS 4.10.

For any data submissions or corrections relating to patients discharged prior to 1st April 2023 hospitals should continue to use OPCS 4.9.

The update from OPCS 4.9 to OPCS 4.10 includes the addition of new codes and the retirement and modification of existing code descriptions and notes.

The table below lists the number changes made to OPCS-4.9 to create OPCS-4.10
